When: Super Sundays will be taking place on the following dates:

- Sun 18 March (3pm till 11pm*)
- Sun 29 April (3pm till 11pm*)
- Sun 24 June (4pm till Midnight*)

Restrictions:

- Volunteers must be able to commit to all three dates
- Volunteers must be aged 18 or over

Benefits/Training:

- Full training and support will be given prior to the event.
- Reasonable travel expenses will be paid.
- NB. If travelling from outside Edinburgh, then bursaries from [People Making Waves](#) are available for travel/accommodation
- If you are aged 18 – 25 you may be eligible for [Saltire Awards](#)
- Super Sunday Event Assistants will receive priority access to future volunteering opportunities taking place in August 2012

Requirements: *Speed of Light* Super Sunday Event Assistants need to:

- Have a good level of fitness and enjoy working outdoors
- Enjoy working as part of a team and have good communication skills
- Be hardworking and enthusiastic about the project
